The plant has started its manufacturing operations after obtaining Consent to operate from Chhattisgarh Environment Conservation Board vide letter no. 4780/TS/CECB/2023 Nava Raipur Atal Nagar, dated 13.09.2023 and the Ethanol produced solely to be used for Ethanol blended petrol program of the Government of India as mentioned in the EC.
